Scholarship

• **Prime Minister's Special Scholarship Scheme (PMSSS), J&K 2019-20** **Eligibility**

The following are eligible for PMSSS:

- Students who are the domiciles of the state of J&K
- Students who have passed 10+2 exam from the J&K Board (JKBOSE) or CBSE affiliated schools located in J&K
- Students who have passed 10+3 Diploma from the J&K State Polytechnic for admission directly in the second year in the prescribed list of Colleges against on the vacant seats of the previous year
- Students having an annual family income of less than INR 8 lakh

Note: The following are **not eligible** for the scholarship-

- Students who do not apply through online registration on AICTE Portal
- Students enrolled in courses offered by Open University
- Students availing benefits from any other Govt./Non-Govt scheme
- Students who joined a college other than those in AICTE Portal
- Students taking admission through agents or NGOs
- Students pursuing any postgraduate programme
- Students absent during the counselling

Benefits

A total of **5000 scholarships** will be awarded for students pursuing courses in General Degree, Engineering Degree, and Medical Streams. Students selected for the scholarship will receive the following benefits:

For General Degree:

- Up to **INR 30,000** per annum for the academic fee (payable to the institution)
- Maintenance charges of **INR 1 lakh** per annum (payable to the student)
- A total of 2070 scholarships to be offered

For Engineering Degree:

- Up to **INR 1.25 lakh** per annum for the academic fee (payable to the institution)
- Maintenance charges of **INR 1 lakh** per annum (payable to the student)
- A total of 2830 scholarships to be offered

For Medical/BDS or Equivalent Medical Streams:

- Up to **INR 3 lakh** per annum for the academic fee (payable to the institution)
- Maintenance charges of **INR 1 lakh** per annum (payable to the student)

Step 2: Select the category: '12th Registration' or 'Diploma Registration'.

Step 3: Fill the registration form with all the required details.

Step 4: Submit and correct any possible errors in the form.

Step 5: Verify the email through the link received on Email/SMS.

Step 6: Complete the registration.

Scholarship

- **Post Matric Scholarship for SC/OBC/EBC/PC/DNT Students 2018-19, Jammu & Kashmir** *Deadline Closed*

Eligibility

An applicant must -

- Be a domicile of Jammu & Kashmir
- Belong to SC, OBC, EBC, PC or DNT category
- Be pursuing studies at post-matriculation level (class 11 to PhD level) within or outside Jammu and Kashmir at a government or government recognized institution
- Have an annual family income less than INR 1 Lakh per annum (for OBC, EBC and PC candidates) and less than INR 2.5 Lakh per annum (for SC and DNTs)

Benefits

The scholarship includes -

- Maintenance allowance
- Payment of compulsory non-refundable fees

Documents

- Passport size photograph of the applicant
- Permanent resident certificate
- Fee receipt
- Attested fee structure by Central/State Government (in the case of private recognised institutions)
- Valid hotelier certificate issued by the institution
- Promotion certificate - duly attested (for students who have passed the previous examination)

Step 8: Once the online application is completed, the applicants are required to submit the hard copy of the completed application form along with Xerox of all supporting documents to the concerned Institution/College/University for verification.

Selection Criteria

- Having a mobile number and email id is mandatory to apply for the scholarship.
- The preference will be given to students studying at government institutions.
- The candidates should not be in receipt of any other scholarship or stipend.

Scholarship

• **NSP Post Matric Scholarships Scheme for Minorities 2019-20**

Eligibility

An applicant must:

- Be studying in class 11,12, graduate, postgraduate, technical or vocational courses, M.Phil or PhD.
- Have secured at least 50% marks or equivalent grades in the previous final examination.
- Belong to the family whose annual income is not more than INR 2 lakh from all the sources.
- Belong to the minority community (Muslim, Sikh, Christian, Buddhist, Jain and Zoroastrian/Parsi).

Benefits

- Admission and tuition fee for classes 11 and 12 (Hostellers and Day Scholars): INR 7,000 per annum
- Admission and tuition fee for technical and vocational courses of classes 11 and 12 levels (Hostellers and Day Scholars): INR 10,000 per annum
- Admission and tuition fee for undergraduate and postgraduate (Hostellers and Day Scholars): INR 3,000 per annum
- Maintenance allowance for 10 months in an academic year for classes 11 and 12 including technical and vocational courses (Hostellers): INR 380 per month
- Maintenance allowance for 10 months in an academic year for classes 11 and 12 including technical and vocational courses (Day Scholars): INR 230 per month
- Maintenance allowance for 10 months in an academic year for courses other than technical and professional courses at undergraduate and postgraduate level (Hostellers): INR 570 per month
- Maintenance allowance for 10 months in an academic year for courses other than technical and professional courses at undergraduate and postgraduate level (Day Scholars): INR 300 per month
- Maintenance allowance for 10 months in an academic year for M.Phil and PhD (Hostellers): INR 1200 per month

How can you apply?

Eligible candidates can apply for the scholarship through following steps -

Step 1: Visit the homepage of the National Scholarship Portal and click on '[New Registration](#)'.

Step 2: Read the guidelines carefully, select the undertaking and '[Continue](#)'.

Step 3: Select the state of domicile, scholarship category (Post Matric), scheme type (scholarship scheme), gender, write the applicant's name, date of birth, mobile number, email ID.

Step 4: Provide the bank details (Bank name, IFSC Code, Account Number)

Step 5: Select Aadhaar or Bank Account Number as identification detail and click on the 'Register' button.

Step 6: The mobile number will be verified and an OTP will be generated.

Step 7: Now, log in using OTP and fill the form.

Step 8: An application ID and password will be generated. Use that for future references.

Note: All the applicants are advised to fill the form correctly, no changes can be made once submitted. The applicants are also advised to fill only one application as multiple applications will lead to the cancellation of the form.

Selection Criteria

- **Fresh:** Weightage will be given according to the financial need of the applicant rather than the marks obtained. In case the family income and the marks of the two applicants are the same, the result will be generated according to the 'Date of Birth' and preference will be given to the senior applicant.
- **Renewal:** The scholar will be eligible for the renewal of the scholarship if obtained 50% in the previous year's examinations in the same course and at the same institute.

Terms and Conditions

30% of the total seats are reserved for the female candidate. The seat will be transferred to the male candidate in case of the non-availability of the female candidate.
