Subject: Establishment of New Medical College at Kathua, Jammu and Kashmir (Govt. Medical College, Kathua, Jammu & Kashmir) by Govt. of Jammu & Kashmir (100 seats) under University of Jammu u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2019-20.

Sir/Madam,

In continuation to this office letter No.MCI-34(41)(E-18)/2019-Med./118368, dated 28/05/2019 and letter No. ME/GAZ-NEW-GMC/36/2019 dated 29.05.2019 of the Principal Secretary to Govt., Health & Medical Education Department, Govt. of Jammu and Kashmir, furnishing required undertaking, I am directed to convey the formal permission of the Board of Governors for establishment of a new medical college at Kathua, Jammu and Kashmir in the name and style of "Govt. Medical College, Kathua, Jammu & Kashmir" with annual intake of 100 MBBS students for the academic year 2019-2020 under Section 10A of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.

2. This permission of the Board of Governors in supersession of the MCI accorded initially for a period of one year and will be renewed on yearly basis subject to verification of achievement of annual targets as indicated in your scheme. This process of renewal of permission will continue till such time the infrastructure and expansion of hospital facilities are completed as per norms of Medical Council of India and the college is recognized. The next batch of students shall be admitted only after obtaining permission of the Board of Governors in supersession of the MCI.

3. Admissions made in violation of the above condition will be treated as irregular and action will be initiated under IMC Act & Regulations made there under.

4. The Government Medical Colleges (except those located in J & K States) shall contribute 15% of MBBS seats for which the renewal permission is granted for all India quota.

5. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of the Board of Governors in supersession of the MCI and the State Govt.

6. Kindly acknowledge receipt of this letter.

ORDER

Consequently upon the essentiality certificate issued by the Health and Medical Education Department, Govt. of J&K vide order No. 230/HME of 2014 dated 23.04.2014, in favour of Government Medical College, Kathua, the inspection of the college was conducted on 03.08.2019, by the committee constituted for the purpose.

The committee after observing below mentioned deficiencies recommends that temporary affiliation be granted in favour of the Government Medical College, Kathua for the session 2019-20 with an intake of 100 seats.

Now, therefore, the Vice Chancellor in anticipation of the approval of the Competent Body is pleased to grant of temporary affiliation in favour of Government Medical College, Kathua subject to fulfillment of the following conditions:

1. The college should remove the deficiencies as pointed out from time to time by the inspection team of MCI.
2. Hostel facility for all the candidates should be made available.
3. At present the college is working in the temporary accommodation and the college should shift to the new premises before March, 2020.
4. Students should register themselves on the NDL (National Digital Library) Portal.


