Notice inviting Quotation

As per the decision taken by purchase committee on 29/04/2020. Sealed quotations are invited from suppliers/wholesalers/authorized dealers/manufacturers on the behalf of Medical Superintendent, Associated Hospital GMC Kathua to meet the demand of drugs/medicines under various departments in the hospital. All the quotations should reach to the office of undersigned within 21 days from the date of publication of this notice in the newspaper. The quotation envelop should contain the heading as “Quotations for the supply of drugs/medicines in GMC Kathua”. The same notice along with the list of drugs/medicines can be downloaded from GMC Kathua website also. www.gmckathua.in.

Terms and conditions:-

- 1) The rates quoted must be for FOR stores of the GMC Kathua.
- 2) The quotation shall have to deposit security money of Rs 10,000 in each case in the shape of CDR/FDR pledge to the Medical Superintendent Associated Hospital GMC Kathua along with the submission of quotation.
- 3) The rates quoted should be inclusive of all taxes, duties, other charges like packing, forwarding etc. No separate tax/levies will be allowed.
- 4) All the requisite documents attached with the bid should be signed, page marked and sealed by the bidder.
- 5) No representation regarding increase/decrease/altering/withdrawal of rates already quoted in the tender shall be considered after the last date of the receipt of the tender and no price escalation claim will be entertained at any stage.
- 6) Only rate against one item will be entertained and accepted for (For Tablet, rate should be quoted for one tablet and for Injection Rate should be quoted for one unit/single ampule). Rate quoted for strip or pack of box will not be entertained.
- 7) The bidders should bid for reputed generic drugs/medicines.
- 8) The bidders should mention the company/make of the medicine/drug for which the price is quoted for every single item/drug/medicine.
- 9) If at any point of time, the supplier selected with the lowest rate could not supply the approved/selected drugs/medicines after the finalization of quotations due to any valid reason then an alternate/substitute drug/medicine will be acceptable only after it is finalized by the purchase committee of this hospital.
- 10) In case if the supply could not be made by the supplier with the lowest rate citing valid reason in writing to the undersigned then the bidder with the second lowest rate will be given preference.
- 11) The suppliers should hold a valid drug license/drug manufacturing license.
- 12) No criminal/blacklist case is pending against the firm in any investigation agency or sub judicious in the court of law.
- 13) All the items shall be sample based except drugs with latest certification and ISO Mark.
- 14) If the supplier fails to supply at the quoted rates or do not execute the order, the undersigned reserves the right to debarring/blacklisting of firm for a period not less than 02 years.
- 15) The purchase committee reserves the right to accept or reject any quotation or a part thereof without assigning any reasons thereof.
- 16) Any disputes if arises shall be to the kathua Jurisdiction.

- 17) If anything is found adverse in respect of documentation or otherwise, legal action warranted under law shall be initiated against the party/firm/supplier.

The quotations must be written in one ink or typed one without any cutting/overwriting. The successful quotationer shall have to execute the supplies immediately of within 15 days from the date of issuance of formal order being a matter of urgency.
